ICON IMAGE

The Holy Nativity of Jesus Christ

On the day of Christ's miraculous birth in Bethlehem, a great and wondrous mystery was revealed, and in the Armenian Church we greet each other with the words:

Christ is Born and is Revealed!
Kreesdos Dzunav yev Haydnetsav!

The mosaic icon portrays the holy family deep in the embrace of a cave where our Lord was born. The awesome expression of doubt on Joseph's face reflects the human question: "How could this be?"

Pondering this miracle of God's birth captures our thoughts also and discloses at the same time that the power of God is far beyond human comprehension.
