TODAY'S GOSPEL: John 14:25-31

"These things I have spoken to you, while I am still with you. But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. PENTECOST—HOKEKALOUST

Pentecost falls on the tenth day after Ascension or fifty days after Easter. Pentecost is the name of two feasts: one Jewish and the other Christian. Pentecost was one of the principal festivals of the early church. The Jewish Pentecost served as a religious celebration at the end of the harvest. Consequently, it was called the Feast of Harvest.

The Christian feast celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles as they were gathered in the Upper Room. They were given grace, the ability to speak in different languages, and the courage to travel everywhere to preach the Good News of Christ. Two of the twelve Apostles, St. Thaddeus [also known as Jude] and St. Bartholomew came to Armenia preaching the Gospel of Christ and setting the seeds of the Christian Faith.

Pentecost is a festival of thanksgiving for the first fruits of the Holy Spirit; thus, it is correlated to the Jewish festival which commemorates the first fruits of nature. In Armenian the name *Hokekaloust*, means "coming of the Holy Spirit."

John Kalajian of the Men's Society of St. John Armenian Church has set up a tour of the Detroit Masonic Temple for Saturday, July 14, 2012. The tour is a family event and children are welcome. The tour will begin at 10 am and last about two hours. There is free parking in the rear of the building off of Second Street. The cost of the tour is a nominal fee of \$5/person which will be donated to the Detroit Masonic Temple Library Fund.

The Masonic Temple is 14 stories tall, has 1037 rooms, has approximately 12 million cubic feet of space, and the main theater stage is the second largest stage in the United States. Besides the seven Craft Lodge Rooms (each having different decorative treatments/styles), there are several ballrooms, a cathedral and a mammoth drill hall comprising 17,500 square feet of open floor space and one of only three "floating floors" to be found in the United States.
