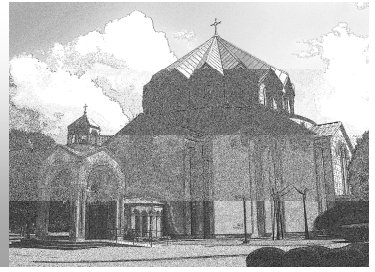

TODAY'S GOSPEL: MATTHEW 24:27-36

"For as the lightning comes from the east and shines as far as the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. Wherever the body is, there the eagles will be gathered together. "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken; then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory; and he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. ASK THE PASTOR

Q. HOW OFTEN SHOULD I ATTEND BADARAK?

A. You should attend *Badarak* and participate in it meaningfully every time it is offered for the rest of your life. From the very beginning the Armenian Church has made the *Badarak* the very center of its life, establishing that it be celebrated every Sunday without fail. At the Last Supper, when Jesus established the Eucharist (Divine Liturgy or *Badarak*) he said, “Do this in remembrance of me” (Luke 22:19, 1 Corinthians 11:24, 25). Jesus is telling us that the *Badarak* is the premiere means by which we can keep God foremost in our lives, hearts and minds. In the *Badarak*, especially when we receive Holy Communion, we encounter God and are filled with his power and love in the most immediate and intimate way possible in this life.

FEAST OF THE DISCOVERY OF THE HOLY CROSS

According to ecclesiastical chronicles, an informed Jew from Jerusalem by the name of Juda was forced to disclose the place where the cross was buried. St. Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine, cast gold pieces into the trash pit where the cross was believed to be buried to hasten the workers who were digging for the Holy Cross. Three crosses were found, one of them being our Lord's, the others belonging to the two criminals crucified with Him. It was necessary to authenticate which of the three crosses was the true cross of Christ. It so happened that a funeral procession bearing a young boy was passing. The queen mother asked that the body be lain upon each cross. Suddenly the young child awoke, whereupon the Queen Helena and her entourage and all nearby venerated the Holy Cross. In another tradition, Bishop Cyril, Patriarch of Jerusalem elevated the Holy Cross before the faithful who, having witnessed the miracle, were awe-inspired and venerated it. The commemoration of this historical event is celebrated on the closest Sunday to October 26 (variable from October 23-29), and is called the Feast of the Discovery of the Holy Cross. It is one of the four feasts of the Holy Cross celebrated by the Armenian Church.
