

When does Life begin?

Oftentimes the faithful of the Armenian Church have questioned when life begins. The Armenian Church fathers who even as early as the 14th Century faced the same question. A beautiful explanation is given below by St. Gregory of Datev.

"The baby being in the mother's womb for forty days takes on the thinking spirit of God. The baby after being presented by God by the sixth day* to the mother, is like the process of fermentation of cheese**. According to the Old Testament Prophet Job, he says; *Did Thou not pour me out like milk and curdle me like cheese ...Chapter 10, Verse 10.*

"For the baby exchanges blood after six days, and until the twentieth day his/her innate spirit develops in the mother's womb ... And from twenty days to forty days his/her senses start to become distinct and take shape as a human being. First comes the head and then other members of the body and the senses and thus with a spirit capable of feeling, grows in the mothers' womb.

In these verses and many more, we see that from the very moment of conception we are known, loved and cared for by God. A developing fetus is a human life, and at whatever state human life is surrounded by, the protection of the love of God is there.

St Gregory of Datev born 1346, + 1410 grew up in the monastery of Datev, then was ordained a celibate priest in Jerusalem. A great theologian and educator, he left the highest standards for the clergy educationally, spiritually and morally. His greatest book, **Kirk Hartzmanz/the Book of Questions** had provided the clearest answers about the theology of our Church until the present time.
