

Thanks to those who responded to our survey last year. We learned a lot about our members and thought you'd be interested in the information collected and opinions shared. The percentages add to more than 100% because some questions allowed for multiple answers.

What are your areas of interest?

1.5% each - Sewing club; Knitting club; Book club

Describe what you would like to see in a women's group & ministry

"Armenian heritage, support, and friendship without judgment (where you are from). Inclusiveness (of) all women from different countries & speaking Armenian certain times."

"More community outreach for the needy, Speakers discussing women's issues, starting a garden group to maintain and create a garden around the St. John sign facing the highway ramp and possibly a "Brides/Meditation Garden"."

"I like to participate in meaningful activities that provide assistance to those in need. I also want these activities to offer opportunities to meet new women while strengthening existing relationships. Projects need to nurture social connections with members while serving others. Fun and fellowship with friends is an important part of ongoing participation."

Anything else you'd like to share?

"Bring back circles to encourage interaction with those you don't know and to ensure volunteers for events."

"When engaging new and young members, we must not 'guide' them toward reproducing past events. We want new and young members to make the Guild 'their' Guild. Sign Up Genius was brought to us by a new young member. Imagine if we had said, 'that's not how we do that' or 'we've never done that before' or 'our women won't go for that.' End on new/young participation. Each new guild member should have a personal/non-related mentor that will share a positive Christian attitude for outreach and fellowship."
