#### **October Guest Speaker**

Prior to the start of the meeting, Joy Callan introduced Liana Aghajanian who spoke to our members about her experiences as an immigrant to the U.S. growing up in California, obtaining her journalism degree, and as a writer who has focused on providing information about people and subjects that often are overlooked. She had recently traveled to Mongolia to write about the use of coal in the country and how it has affected the



health of the women in the area. She explained how she had written an article about an underground LGBTQ night club that became famous throughout the world. She submitted this published article to a competition in Detroit that encouraged young writers by offering the winner a free house. Liana's article was the winner and she moved from her parents' home in California to Hamtramck two years ago. She was both excited and apprehensive as she started out on her own for the first time. She described her adjustment to living in the Midwest, making new friends, and having new experiences and continuing her career as an independent journalist. She is hoping to use her experiences and her interest in Armenian food and culture to write a book in the near future. Her presentation was enjoyed by all those present. Joy presented her with the St Johns Women's Guild cookbook and a bag of khalkha as a gift. — Cathy Zwinck


